Transfer of Current Year Surplus to Reserve

WHEREAS, the Rochelle Park Board of Education wishes to deposit anticipated current year surplus into a Capital Reserve account at year end, subject to the verification upon completion of the Audit, and

WHEREAS, the Rochelle Park Board of Education will not exceed the maximum allowable amount defined by the district's Long Range Facility Plan to be transferred to the Capital Reserve Account; and

WHEREAS, the Rochelle Park Board of Education wishes to deposit the first \$250,000.00 as tax relief for the 20172018 budget year, then transfer the remaining monies above the excess of the 2% cap in surplus into the Capital Reserve account.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Rochelle Park Board of Education, that it hereby authorizes the district's School Business Administrator to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.

Mrs. Judge Cravello also asked for clarification of this resolution.

Dr. Zoeller any surplus money left over goes into the capital reserve account for tax relief over the amount of \$250,000.00.

Mrs. Judge Cravello asked if that would help with the 2017-18 school budget.

Dr.Zoeller confirmed that is what it would be used for. This past May the district used money from the audited figures to offset taxes for next year.
