Please consider donating any items to help us earn our award and assist the facility in the caring and sheltering of these homeless animals.

- Clean sheets, towels, blankets or comforters
- Clean cages & pet carrier
- Dog crates
- Adjustable Martingale collars
- Canned dog & canned puppy food
- Canned cat & kitten food
- Unopened bags of dry cat or dog food
- Dog Treats
- Cat toys, cat trees, and scratching posts
- Plush squeaky dog toys & tennis balls
- Plastic storage bins
- Durable, rugged dog toys & rope toys for our tough chewers (Nylabone)
- Enrichment toys (i.e. Kong, Busy Buddy Twist-n-Treat, Buster Cube, Tug-a-Jug)
- Cat litter
- Small plastic or metal litter boxes (clean catering trays work great!)
- Water bowls, specifically medium sized ceramic bowls and ones that clip onto crates/cages
- Any meat baby food (no onion or garlic)
- Heating Pads
- Snuggle Safes (microwaveable heating disks)
- Pill Pockets
- Clean, small stuffed animals for kittens to cuddle with
- Unscented baby wipes
- Paper towels
- Bleach
- Shoe boxes or small boxes suitable for cat or kitten beds
- Wee-wee pads
- YARN (ANY COLOR) We have a volunteer that makes homemade blankets for the animals
- Gift certificates/cards to pet supply stores
- Gift bags or baskets with a handle (adopters of "urgent" or special needs animals get special gifts inside for such a good deed!)
